The training includes all training delivered at a Certificate II level plus it focuses on

- **Advanced Floristry Design Skills:**

Contemporary Structural design skills, Application of European design fundamentals, extensive training in classic and contemporary Bridal bouquet skills, Intermediate Funeral design skills, Practical application of creating a shop display and Commercial shop ideas for every day work, advanced commercial design ideas including gift items and speed training.

- **Advanced retail knowledge and retail management skills**

Application of advanced product knowledge, advanced Sales processes including Quoting of Weddings and other design work, basic marketing Skills including demographic research and how to design and implement a promotional strategy, Coordinate work teams.

- **Work experience:** Application of practical skills in the workplace
